- General activities - Using public park	 Undesirable people Exposure to weather Creature sting or bite Soft tissue injury Missing student 	 Amaroo staff to discuss safety rules and expectations. Signals and procedures explained at beginning of day (e.g. 3 blasts of whistle means go to nearest teacher or return to base, whichever is closest). Students ask permission and go in pairs to toilet if in the field. Students to wear hat and encouraged to wear sunscreen and drink water from own water bottles or as supplied by school/Amaroo. Visiting teacher to have bus company number if evacuation is needed. Amaroo teacher to be aware of weather forecast. First aid kit and anaphylaxis pen carried. Communication device carried at all times. Class teachers do head count at beginning and end of day 	Low
- Plant ID/ vegetation survey/bushwalk	- Stings & bites - Tripping	 Amaroo staff to discuss safety rules and expectations. Students told to stay on path unless otherwise necessary. Students alerted to watch for thorny or stinging species (e.g. Bull Ants, Paper Wasps, African Boxthorn) Students advised not to step over logs/other objects where they cannot see and if they do see a snake, to calmly alert teachers and slowly back away from it. Areas where any snake sightings occur will be avoided. First aid kit (incl. bandages) and anaphylaxis pen carried. Visiting teacher to have bus company number if evacuation is needed. Communication device carried at all times. 	Low
- Soil analysis	- Chemical exposure	 Amaroo staff to discuss safety rules and expectations. Appropriate PPE used (gloves, eye protection) 	Low
- Invertebrate sampling	- Stings & bites	 Appropriate PPE used (gloves) Tweezers supplied to handle invertebrates 	Low
