

## Camping – Activity list and risks – 2020

Activity	Hazards	Control measures if needed	Risk level
- Play time - General activities	<ul> <li>Weather exposure.</li> <li>Creature sting or bite.</li> <li>Soft tissue injury.</li> <li>Missing student.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Amaroo staff to be aware of weather forecast and adapt activities accordingly.</li> <li>Students to wear closed shoes, hat and encouraged to drink water.</li> <li>First aid kit carried on bush walk and kept at camping area.</li> <li>Communication device carried at all times.</li> <li>Anaphylaxis pen accessible.</li> <li>Signals and procedures explained at beginning of day.</li> <li>Amaroo staff to observe students in case of heat stress or other physical/ mental stresses and adapt activities accordingly.</li> <li>Visiting teachers to supervise play time and do a head-count at the start of each program activity.</li> <li>Amaroo teachers to advise boundaries and procedures regarding playing in the grounds.</li> </ul>	Low
- Using binoculars	- Injury	<ul> <li>Students told to stand still when looking through binoculars, "do not walk about while looking through binoculars".</li> </ul>	Low
- Playing with camping equipment.	- Injury	- Safe use of camping equipment demonstrated by Amaroo staff.	Low
- Bushwalk	<ul> <li>Weather exposure</li> <li>Creature sting or bite.</li> <li>Lost student.</li> <li>Soft tissue injury.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>First aid kit carried on bushwalk and kept at camping area.</li> <li>Amaroo staff to observe students in case of heat stress or other physical/ mental stresses and adapt bushwalk accordingly.</li> <li>Amaroo staff to lead bushwalk and other adult to tail the group.</li> <li>Bushwalk path known and risks regularly mitigated, i.e. Dead trees removed, path cleared and insect activity managed.</li> </ul>	Medium
