Activity	Hazards	Control measures if needed	Risk level
General activities, including lunch play etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Weather exposure. - Creature sting or bite. - Soft tissue injury. - Missing student. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Amaroo staff to be aware of weather forecast and adapt activities accordingly. - Students to wear closed-in shoes, hat and encouraged to drink water. - Anaphylaxis pen accessible. - Signals and procedures explained at beginning of day. - Amaroo staff to observe students in case of heat stress or other physical/ mental stresses and adapt activities accordingly. - Visiting teachers to supervise play time and do a head-count at the start of each program activity. - Amaroo teachers to advise boundaries and procedures regarding playing in the grounds. 	Low
Mud play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ingesting mud. - Injury from mud contaminate. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adult supervision to ensure no students eat mud. - Mud to be free of contaminates and sharp objects. 	Medium
Sand play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Injury from sand contaminate. - Sand being thrown. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sand to be raked before the program day. - Students asked not to throw or flick sand. 	Low
Rock play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Injury, bruising, crushed finger etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adult supervision and guidelines explained before play – “rocks to be only picked up and placed not thrown or dropped.” 	Medium
Natural loose parts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Allergic reaction. - Eye injury. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students with severe allergies to nuts/ plant material will be noted and will not participate in this activity. - Supervision – adult given card with guidelines and safety triggers. - Natural loose parts will be examined to exclude known allergy triggers 	Low

Construction zone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Soft tissue injury. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adult supervision to ensure students are safe. - Logs to be no more than 30cm high. - Demonstration of how to lift planks and tyres safely. 	Medium
Secret garden Music station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students near road. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adult supervision. - Area checked at beginning of day. 	Low
Gorri	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Soft tissue injury. - Weather exposure. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gorri played on even grassed area. - Students to sit in shade while game is being explained. 	Low
Sensory activity & Bushwalk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Weather exposure. - Creature sting or bite. - Soft tissue injury. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bushwalk path known and risks regularly mitigated, i.e. Dead trees removed, path cleared and insect activity managed. - Amaroo staff to lead bushwalk and other adult to tail the group. - First aid kit carried on bushwalk. - Communication device carried at all times. 	Medium
Day dream flop	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creature sting or bite. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tarp placed on ground for lying on. - Tarp checked for ants etc. before asking students to lie down. 	Low
