<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bushwalk 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Weather exposure. - Creature sting or bite. - Soft tissue injury. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Amaroo staff to observe students in case of heat stress or other physical/ mental stresses and adapt bushwalk accordingly. - Bushwalk path known and risks regularly mitigated, i.e. Dead trees removed, path cleared and insect activity managed. - Amaroo staff to lead bushwalk and other adult to tail the group. - First aid kit carried on bushwalk. 	Medium
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tree shake 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creature sting or bite. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tree shake is undertaken in defined area and students are told the correct procedure. 	Low
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meat ant experiments 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Creature sting or bite. - Preparation of food materials. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meat ants are used for experiment as they do not sting. - Allergies of any students are noted for egg, dairy, meat, insect, nuts and consequently program adjusted. 	Low
