- Support the Darling Downs and South West Region STEM Hub through the employment of a Science and Innovation Regional Coordinator in partnership with the Department of Environment and Science (DES) Partner Up Qld for Science and Innovation Program. DES are providing \$70,000 which will contribute to the majority of the employment costs. Amaroo EEC will be the host centre for this program during 2022.

Our initiatives include

- Conduct a Science and Innovation Roadshow to the schools in the western parts of the DDSW Region using our mobile Science Van.
- Support Science Week and other Science and innovation events and activities for teachers and students throughout the year.

- Engage students and teachers in Science and Innovation activities across the DDSW Region
- Identify the expected costs of human and physical resources.
 - Employment costs = \$5,000
 - Program resources = \$633
