## This funding will be used to

- Employ a part-time, 0.2 Full Time Equivalent (FTE), Unit Support Officer to improve our centre grounds and assist in the implementation of environmental and Indigenous education programs which will improve the quality and diversity of services provided to our client schools.

## Our initiatives include

- Provide support for our current Unit Support Officer (USO) position to assist in the development and delivery of our programs plus focus on grounds improvement, especially after the construction of our new Eco Classroom.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Supporting the implementation of programs in Outdoor and Environmental Education Centres.
- Partially funding the employment of a part-time USO for one day per week to support the implementation of our current programs. We cater for approximately 7,000 students and 300 teachers from 40 schools per year. \$5362
- We have a detailed Learnscape Plan for our centre grounds, which forms a critical part of our environmental education teaching and learning resource and our grounds need remediation after the construction of the new Eco Classroom.
