| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Simple orienteering - Walking around dam foreshore - Bird watching | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Vehicle traffic - Large body of water | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Amaroo staff to lead walk and orienteering activity and avoid hazards such as vehicles, mud, large sticks etc. - Students told to stay away from foreshore of Dam – Amaroo staff and visiting teacher to closely supervise. - Student to always stay behind Amaroo staff while working on or near the road areas. - Students told to stand still when looking through binoculars, “do not walk about while looking through binoculars”. | Medium |
